E-Vote – November 17, 2014 – Name Approval for All Creatures Animal Hospital Ltd.

Background:

Friday, November 7, 2014 Council Meeting – agenda item #3.2.1 – Motion put forward:

“MOTION R141104: THAT the name All Creatures Animal Hospital Ltd. be approved as a practice or practice facility name effective November 7, 2014 in accordance with s. 37 of the CVBC Bylaws.”

The motion was moved and seconded and discussion ensued. Council members defeated the motion as the name of the veterinary practice currently located in Langley is ‘Small Creatures Pet Clinic’ and Council felt the location was in too close proximity to ‘All Creatures Animal Hospital Ltd.’ that was to be opened in Aldergrove.

When advising Dr. Philip Andersen of the outcome of the decision it came to light that the CVBC office had inadvertently showed the practice location as Aldergrove which is Dr. Andersen’s home address; the practice is to be opened in Vancouver.

Given the new information, Council members voted unanimously in favour on the following motion:

MOTION E141117: THAT the MOTION R141104 that was defeated by Council on Friday, November 17, 2014 be carried: therefore, the name All Creatures Animal Hospital Ltd. be approved as a practice or practice facility effective November 7, 2014 in accordance with s. 37 of the CVBC Bylaws.
